10,000-foot grid based on South Carolina coordinate system, north  
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17,  
shown in blue.  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 12 meters south and  
17 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.  
Revisions shown in purple and woodland compiled in cooperation  
with State of South Carolina agencies from aerial photography  
taken 1987 and other sources. This information not field checked.  
Map edited 1990.



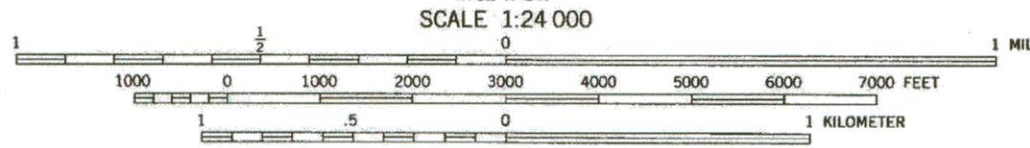
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550, Provisional Locations of Cemeteries, Graves, and Burial Grounds in
